The Fourth Degree

The Fourth Degree is a separate, and is not the highest degree of the order. Members of this degree are addressed as "Sir Knight". The Primary purpose of the fourth degree is to foster the spirit of Patriotism and to encourage active Catholic citizenship. A Knight is eligible to Join the Fourth Degree after Six months from his first degree date., providing he has completed the second and third degrees beforehand.

Assemblies are distinct from councils, and have separate officers. The Supreme Board of Directors appoints a Supreme master and twenty Vice Supreme Masters to govern the Fourth Degree. Each vice supreme master oversees a Province, which is divided into Districts. The Supreme Master appoints District Masters to supervise several assemblies. The Master is responsible for all Color Corp Activities in his district. The Master also reports his activities to the State Deputy. The State Deputy is in charge of all Knights of Columbus activities in his state.

Each assembly is led by a Navigator. The Navigator is responsible for what happens in the assembly. He also appoints a Color Corps Commander to oversee the color corps at Fourth degree activities. The color corps commander serves at the discretion of the Navigator
